OLS Covid-19 Policy as of 8/22/2022

We have condensed the updated information into the two boxes below. This is the protocol in its simplest form, and we will be following this moving forward.

Quarantine — **Exposure to COVID** (for students who have had close contact exposure to a positive case):

No quarantine required. Wear a well-fitting mask and take precautions for 10 days from exposure. If symptoms develop, Isolate immediately.

Test on Day 6. If Positive test, isolate immediately. If Negative test, continue taking precautions through day 10.

*Day count (day 0 is last day of exposure to someone with COVID, wear a well-fitting mask).

Isolation – Tested Positive for COVID (for students who are positive for COVID):

Students must isolate for 5 days and can return on day 6, if they are symptom free for 24 hours without any medication and must wear a mask on days 6 - 10.

*Day Count (day 0 is the day symptoms start or positive test date, isolation is for the next 5 days, and return is on day 6 if criteria above is met)

Lab tests are no longer required to confirm a positive case of COVID for the school records. We can accept home tests as verification. If you do give your child a home test, and it comes back positive, please label the test with your child's name, the date, and the time. Please take a picture of the labeled results and send them to Belia.
