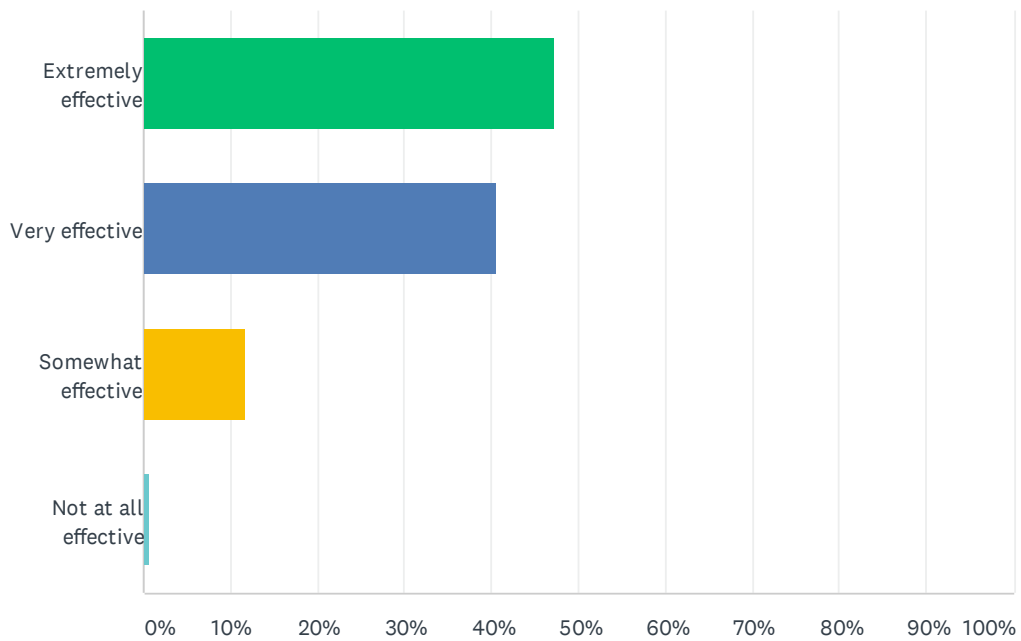

Q11 How would you rate the education your children are receiving in Mathematics

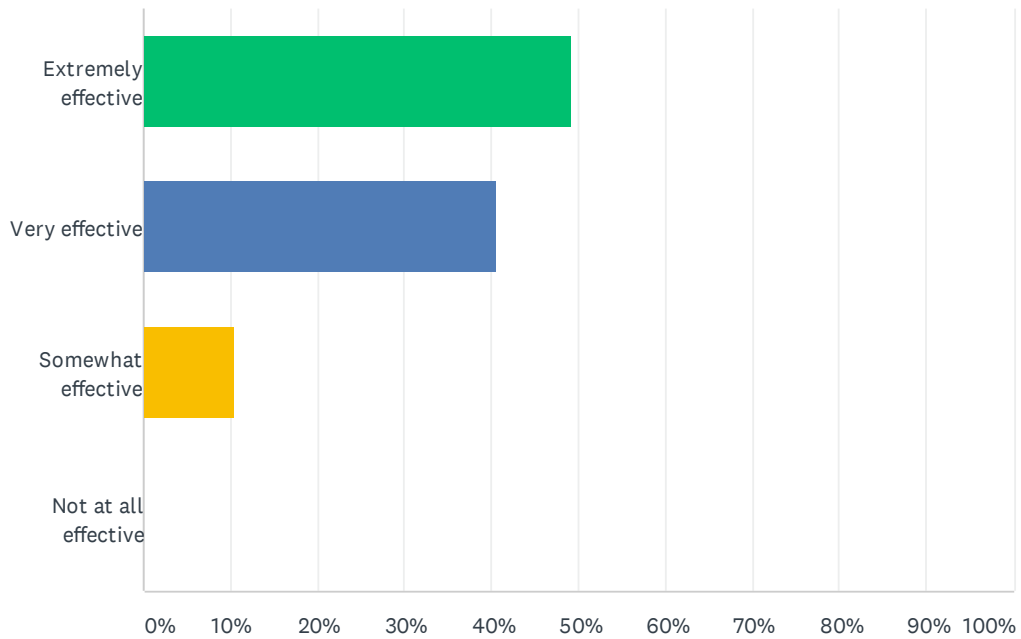

Q12 How would you rate the education your children are receiving in Reading / Literature

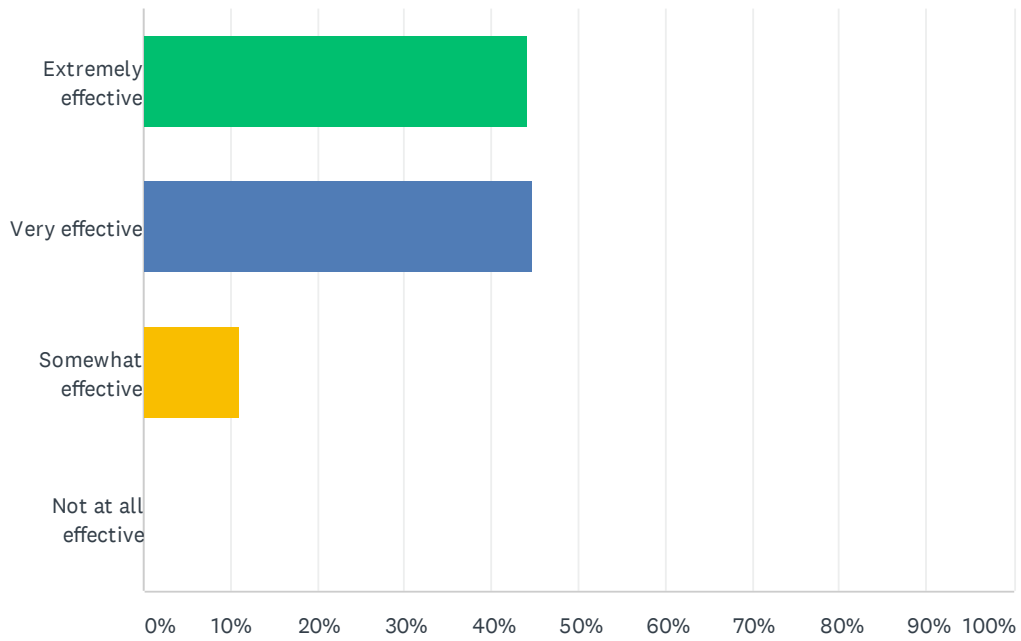

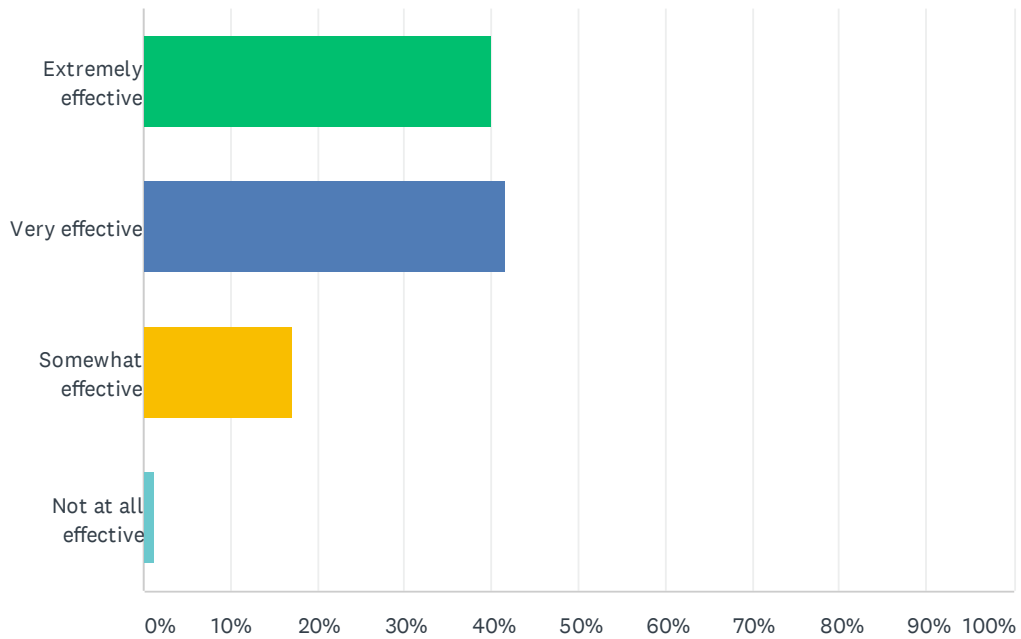

Q14 How would you rate the education your children are receiving in Science

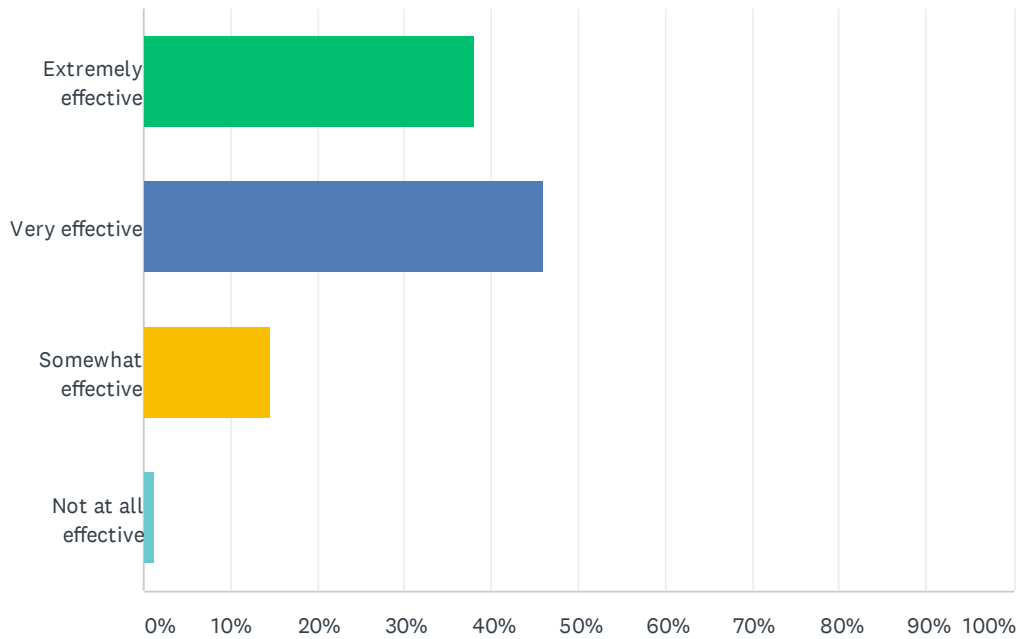

Q15 How would you rate the education your children are receiving in Social Studies

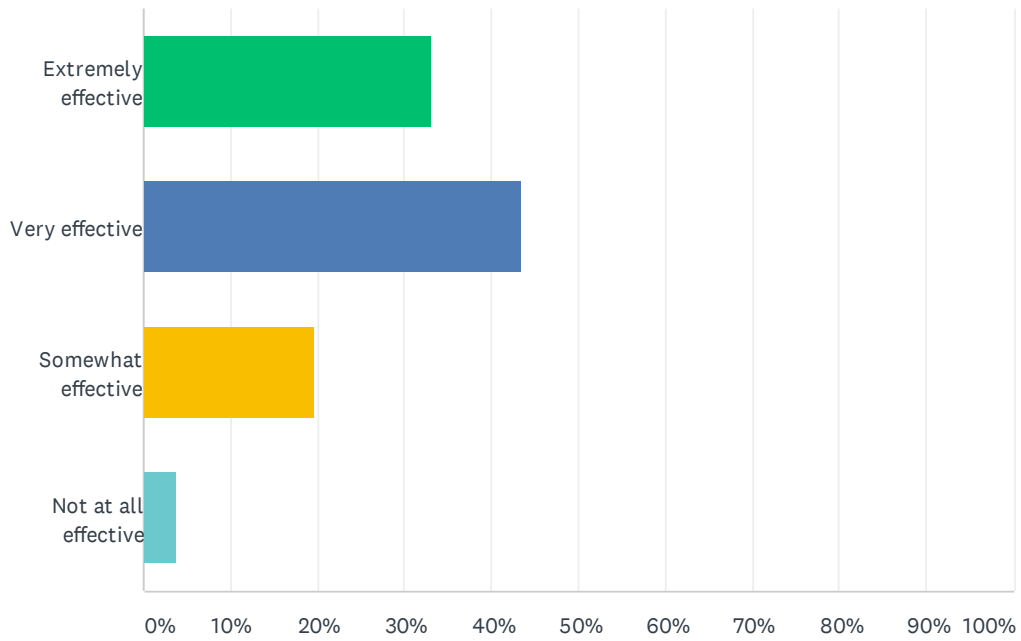

Q16 How would you rate the education your children are receiving in Computers

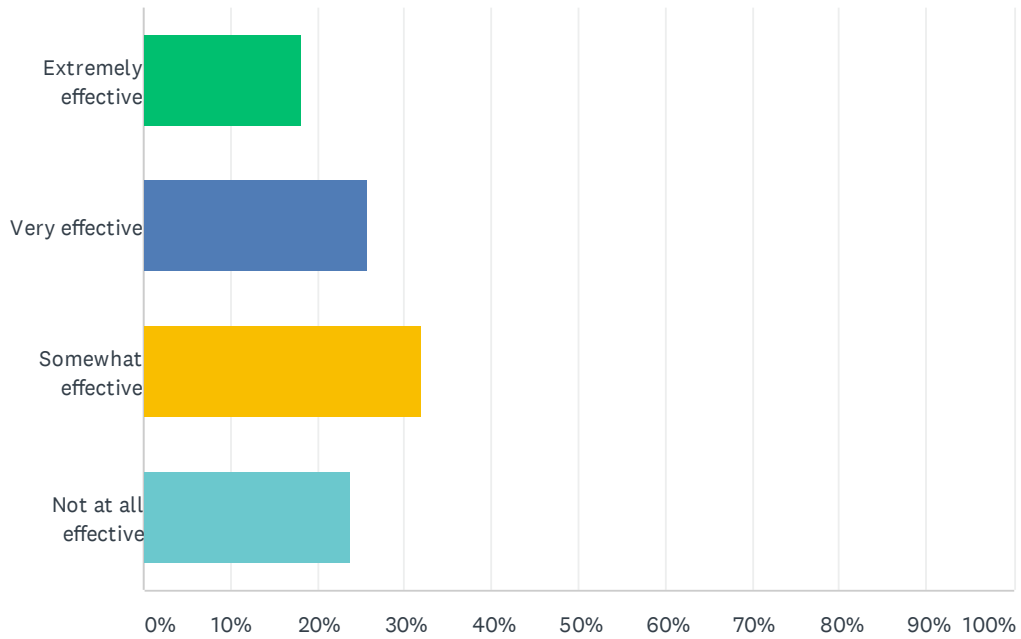

Q17 How would you rate the education your children are receiving in Music

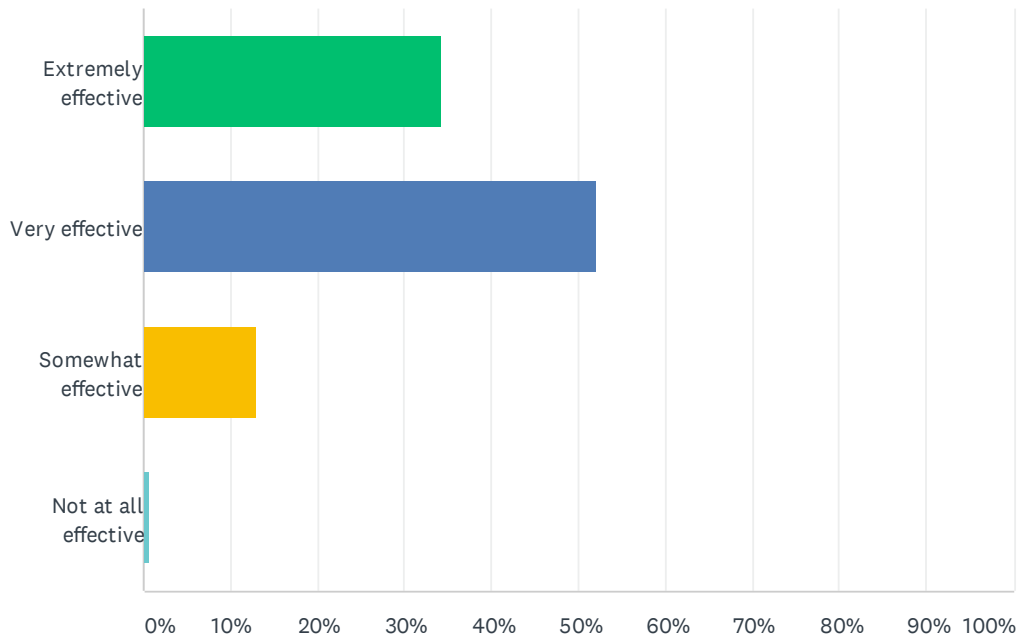

Q18 How would you rate the education your children are receiving in Physical Education

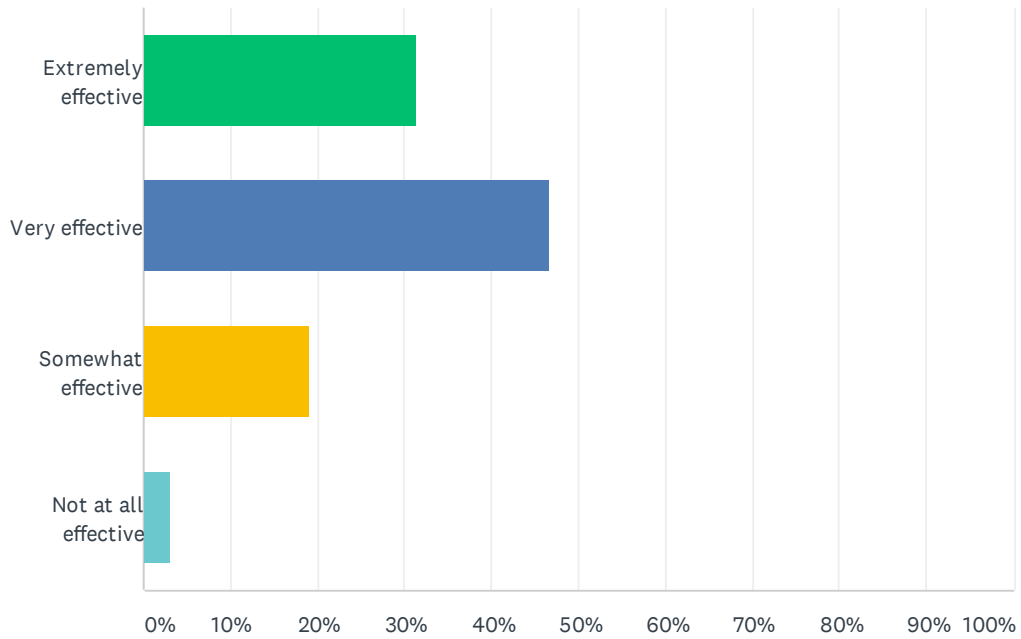

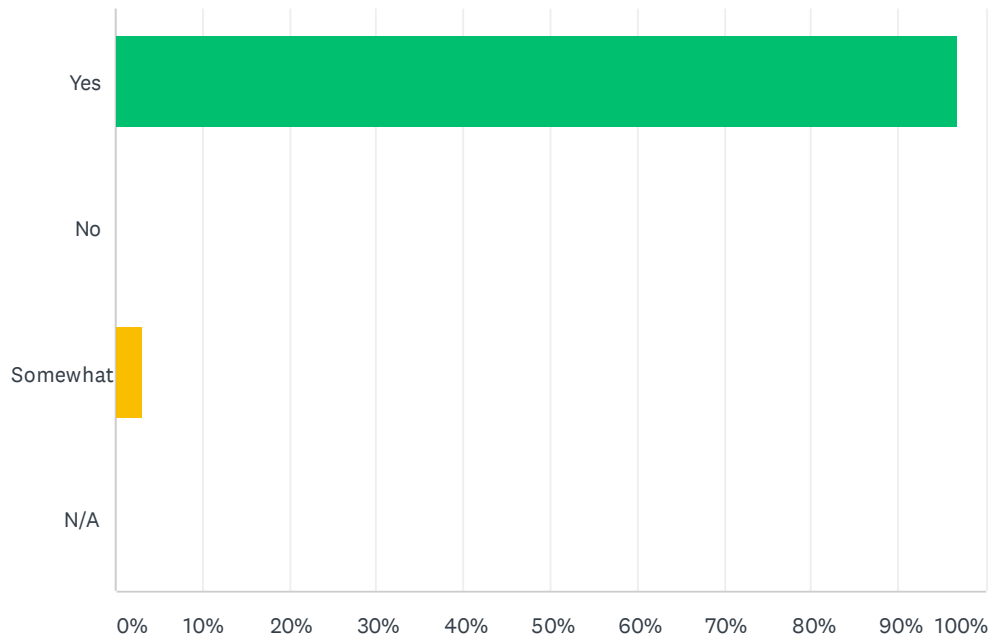

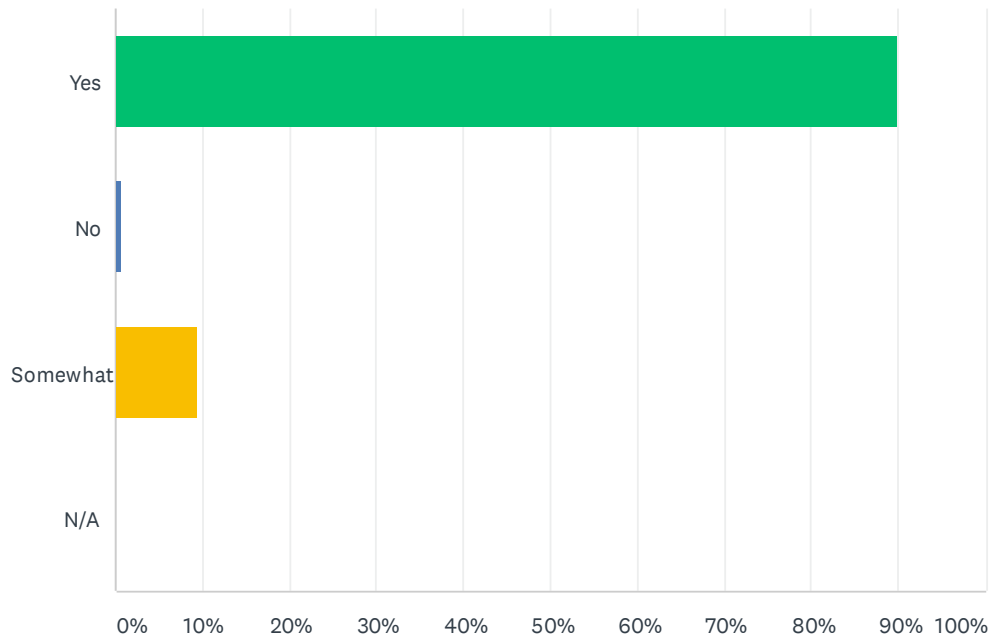

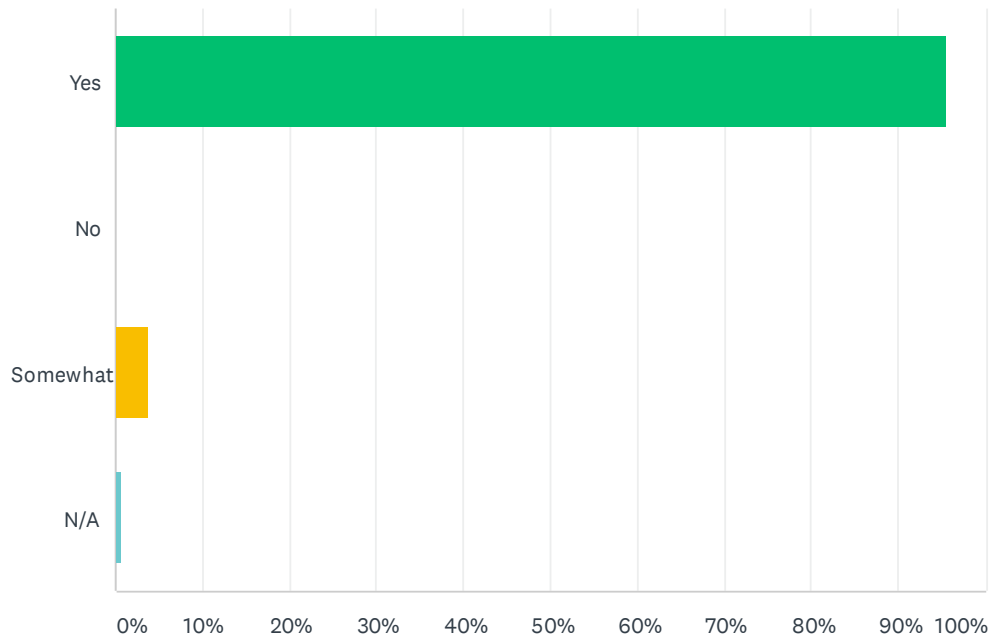

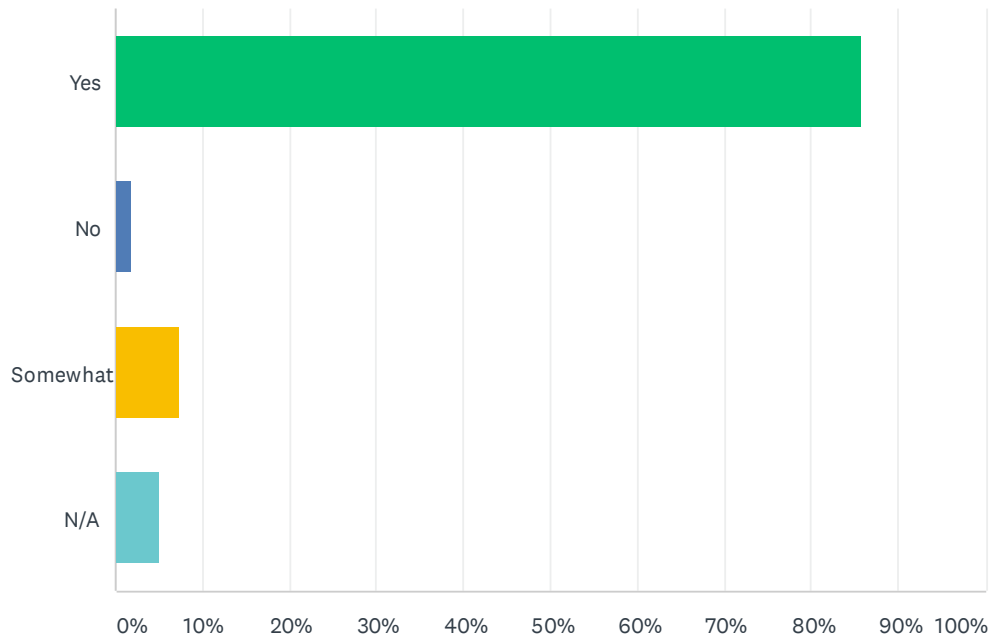

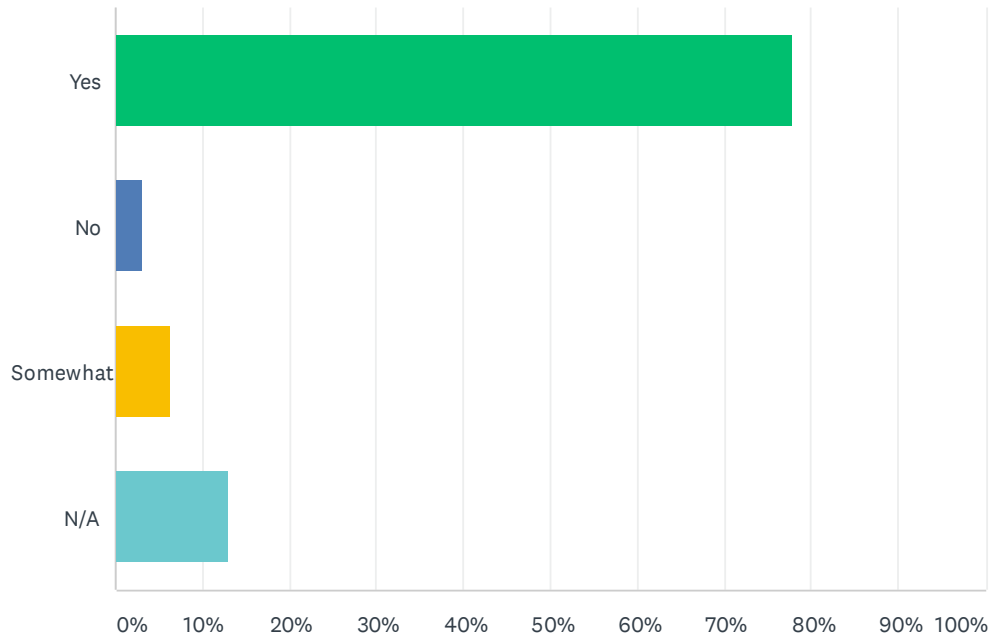

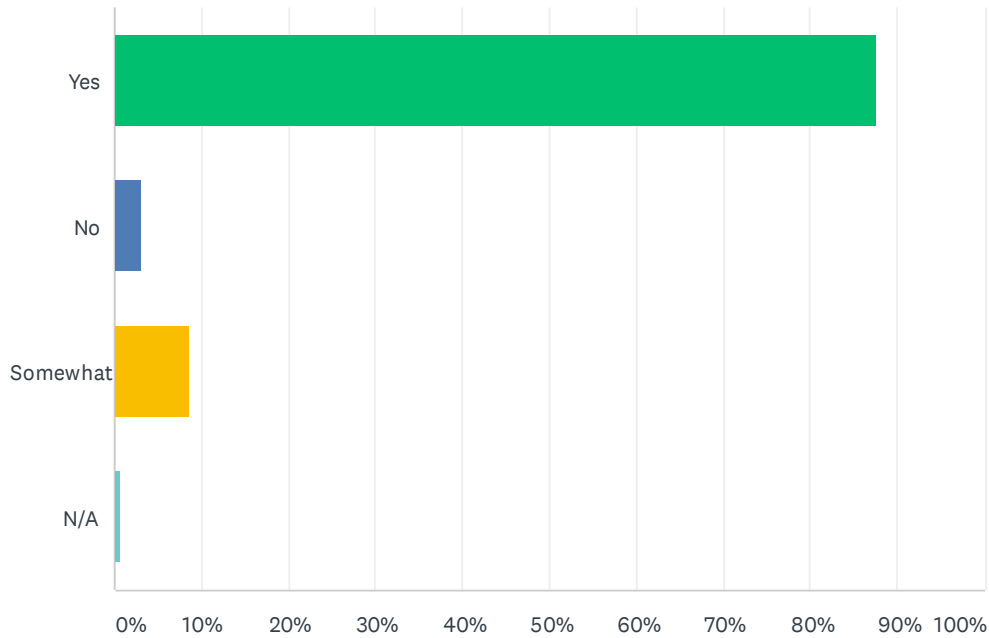

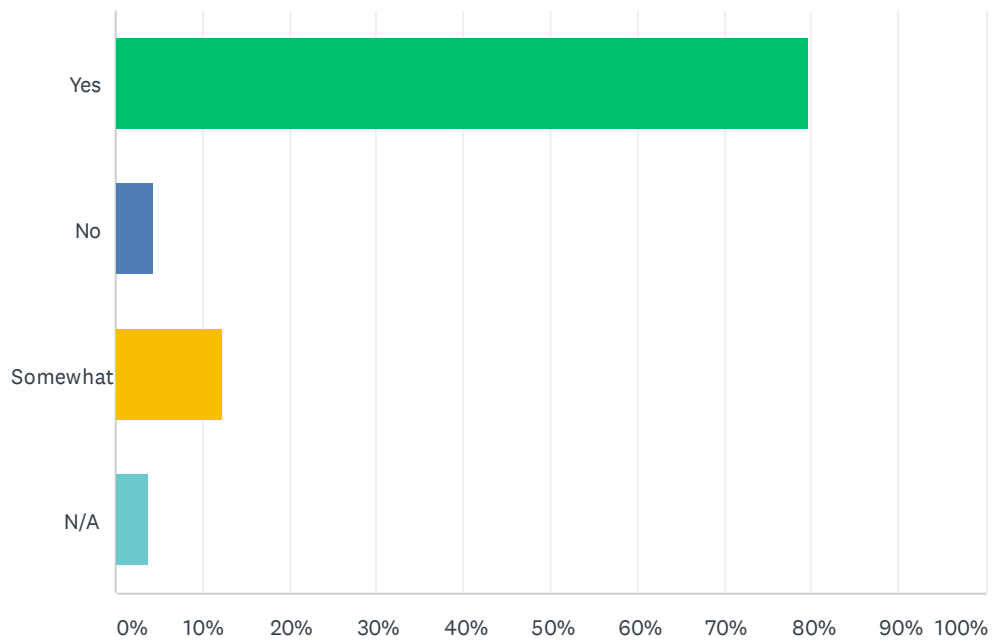

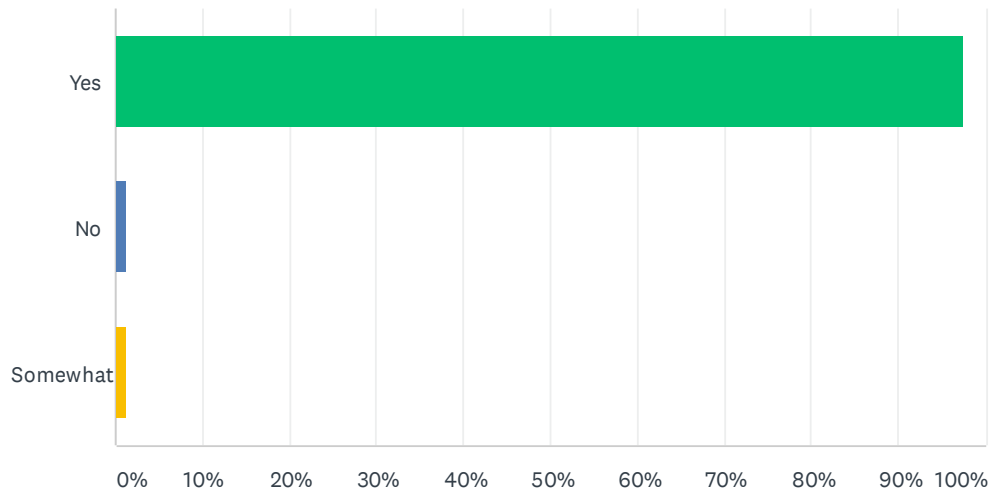

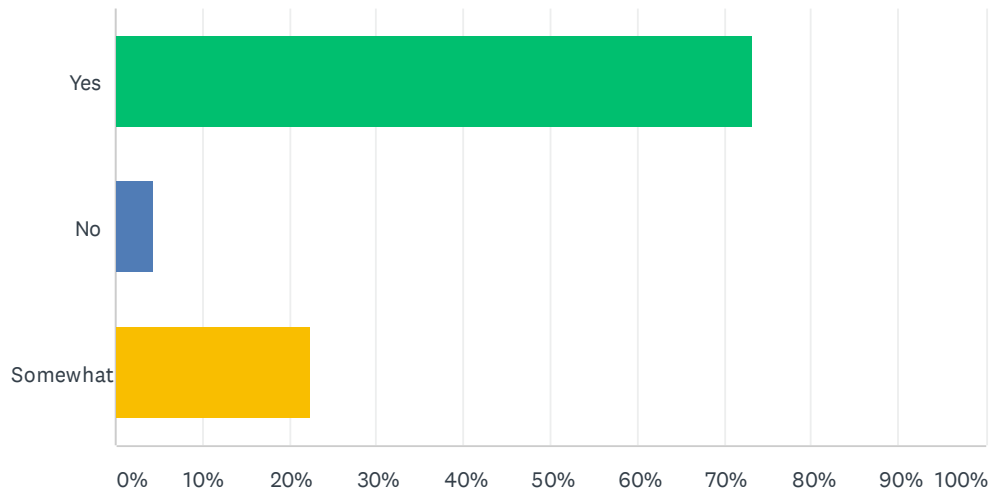

Q47 In our school, do teachers provide frequent feedback to students and parents concerning academic progress?

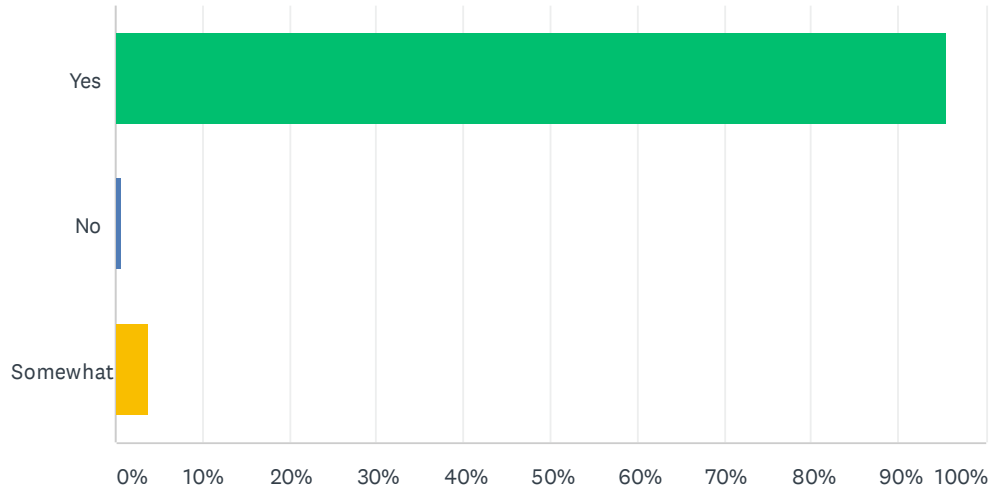

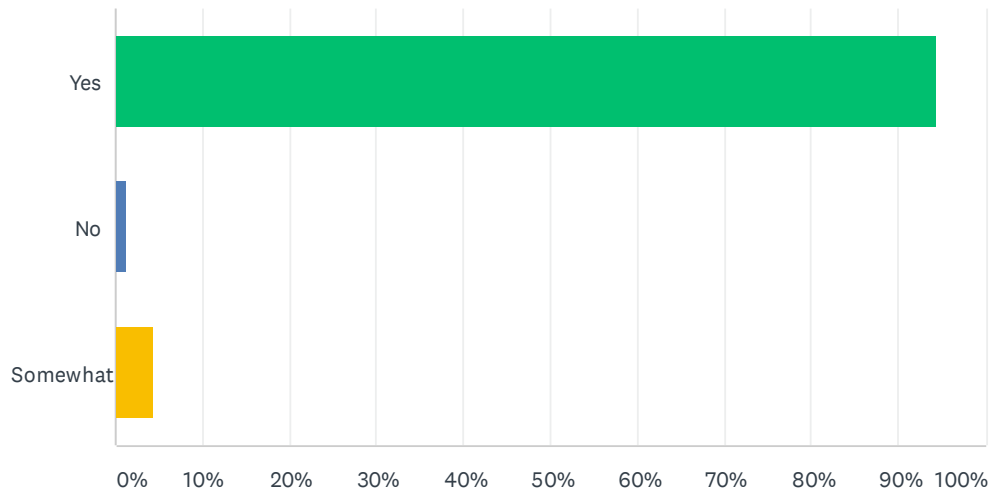

Q49 Do most of the students and teachers in our school respect each other and have good working relationships?

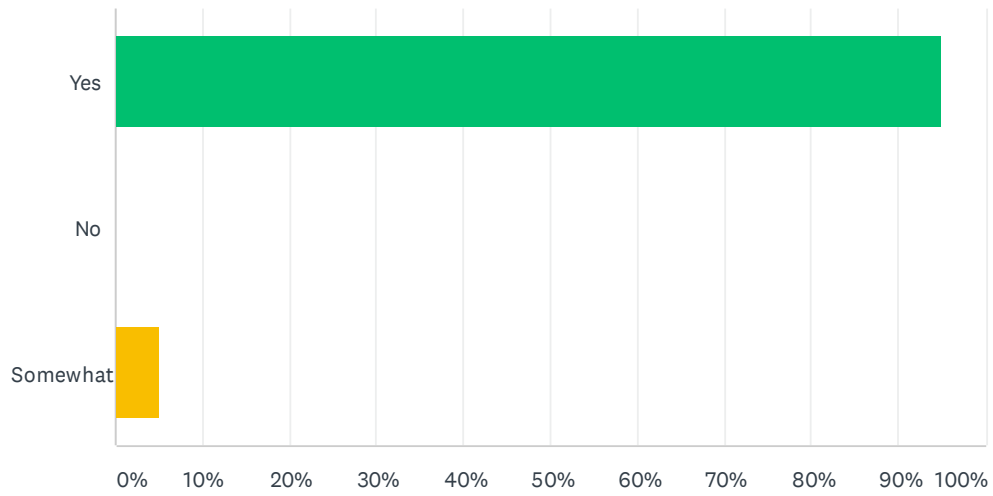

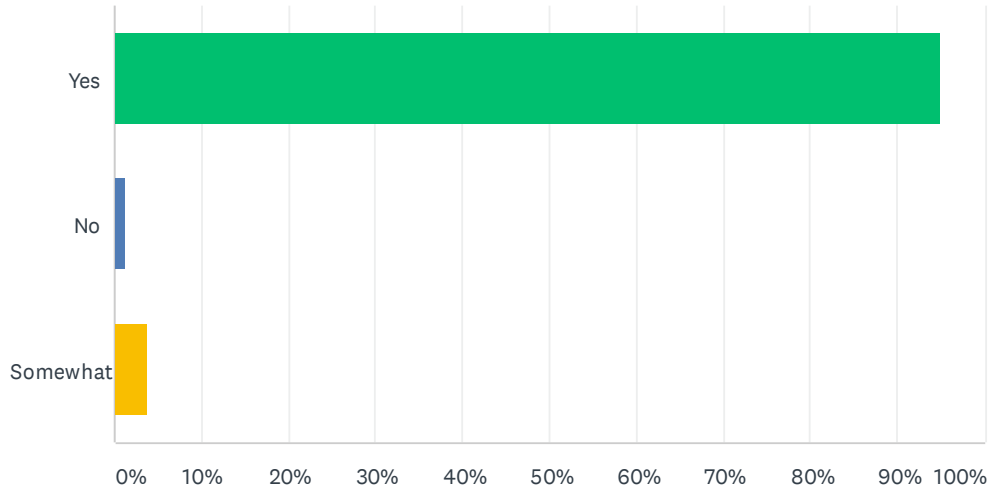

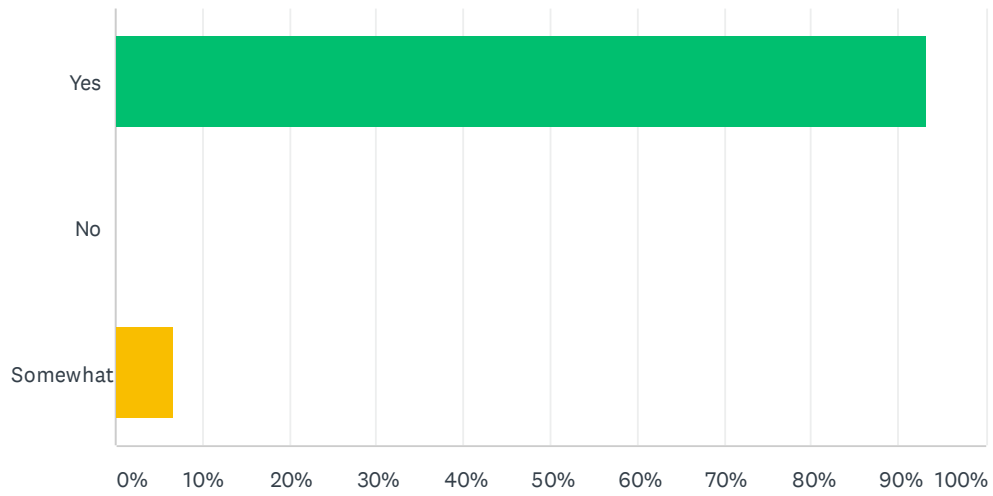

Q53 Do you feel that the school bulletin keeps you informed of the school's activities?

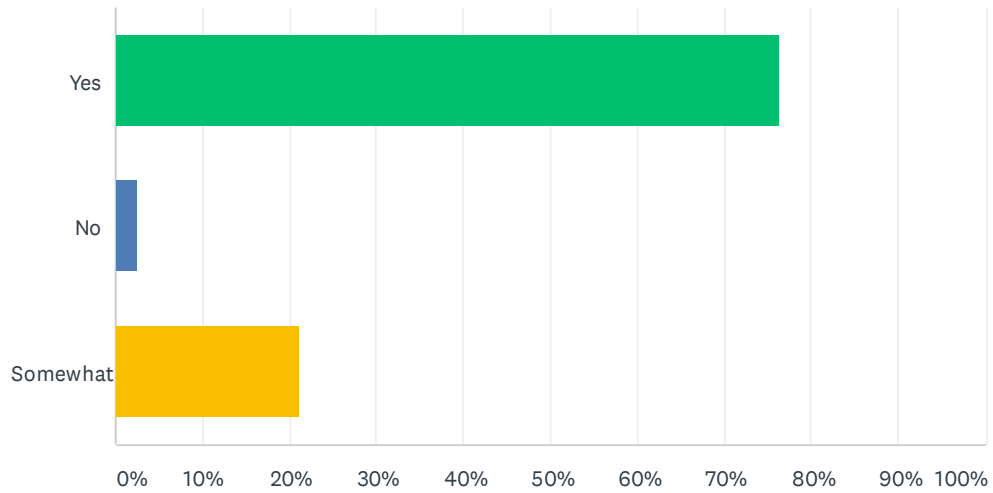

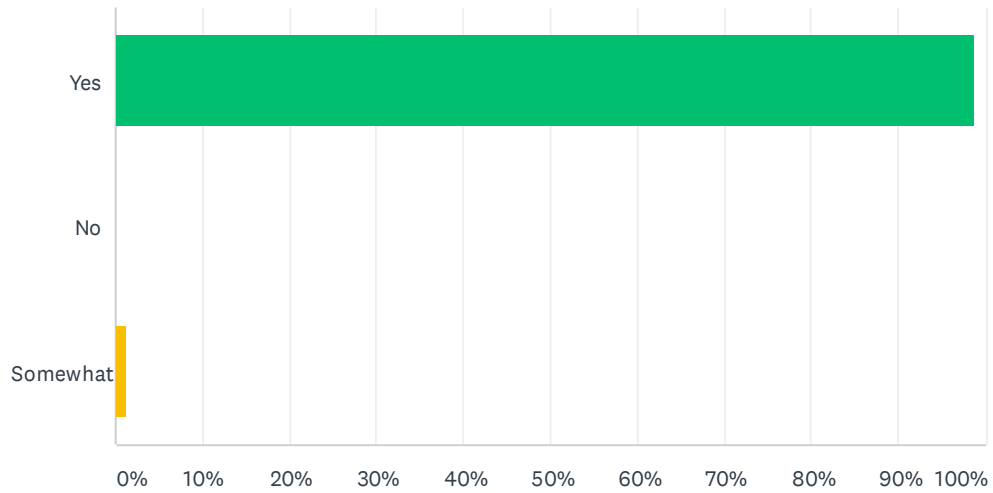

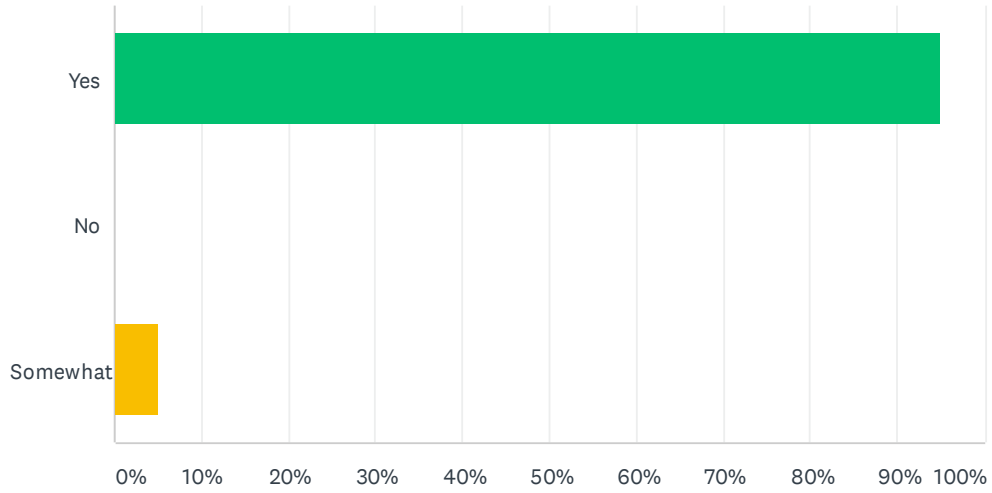
